MASTER PLAN

NEW/OLD BUSINESS

Mayor Denner noted Mack Ave in Grosse Pointe Park is continuing its streetscape project along Wayburn-Maryland, Lakepointe-Beaconsfield, Beaconsfield-Nottingham the City of Grosse Pointe Park would like to mirror the same street lights and trees onto the Detroit side of Mack. Discussion is taking place for funding of lights including with the Eastside Community Network, about \$4,000/Pole.

Resident asked if the Planning Commission determined roads for 2018 paving and future paving projects. Mayor Denner mentioned that decision is up to the City Administration and City Council. Mayor Pro Tem Clark discussed the current road millage expiring and how the City allocated funding for local streets. New road millage will address major streets, curb, parking lots. Road contractor will redo part of Barrington this fall at no cost to the City.

Resident inquired about making a one way on Kercheval from Beaconsfield to the round- about at Wayburn. Mayor Denner referred resident to discuss with City Administration.

With no further business the meeting adjourned at 6:42 pm.
